Filing your Will with the Clerk's office is not required but the "Original" must be presented at the time the Will is Probated. I suggest you keep your "Original" and several extra duplicate copies in a safe and secure location. I apologize that our office is not furnished with enough storage space to keep our member's Last Will and Testaments on file.
